



Summer Camps Frequently Asked Questions

What is CodeCrew Summer Camps?

CodeCrew offers Summer programs to children ranging from Kindergarten to 12th grade through a 6-week intensive hands-on summer experience. We will be covering a variety of offerings with a special focus each week to give students different perspectives on Computer Science.

Where will Summer Camps be held?

Our Summer Camps will be held at the Museum of Science and History (MoSH), formerly known as the Pink Palace located at 3050 Central Ave, Memphis, TN 38111.

When will Summer Camps start and end?

Summer Camps will start on the first week of June 12th and end July 20th.

What time does Summer Camps start and end?

Summer camps will start at 10am and end at 3pm.

Does my student need to bring their own laptop?

We encourage students to bring their own device, however we will have devices on site for students to use.

Will lunch be provided?

Lunch will not be provided. Please bring your lunch in an insulated lunch box. Refrigerators and microwaves are not available.

Will water be available for students?

Water fountains will be accessible to students. We encourage students to bring refillable water bottle to stay hydrated throughout camp.

Will snacks be available for students?

Light snacks will be available and will be offered only during break times.

What type of cloths should my student wear?

Students should wear something comfortable to summer camp. Classrooms can get cold. We recommend bring a light jacket.

What type of shoes should my student wear?

We recommend your students wear comfortable closed-toed shoes. They will be walking around throughout the day. Please, no flip-flops or open-toed shoes.

What happens if the camp is full and I have not registered yet?

Due to high demand, spots will be limited at CodeCrew's 2023 Summer Camp. In this scenario, you will be placed on a waitlist. Our team notify you should a spot open up.
