



## PHOTOGRAPH/MEDIA CONSENT AND RELEASE

I hereby give consent and authorize employees of CodeCrew to take photographs and/or motion pictures/video of my child or other types of media productions that capture my child's name, voice, and/or image (henceforth called the "Materials" in this form).

I agree that my child and/or I am participating on a voluntary basis and will not receive any payment from CodeCrew and/or Memphis Grizzlies Foundation and/or other third parties for signing this release or as a result of any publication of the Materials.

## RELEASE OF LIABILITY STATEMENT

This clause contains specific measures that CodeCrew reserves the right to provide, and/or hire, and/or collaborate with third party affiliates, and third party community programs, and/or volunteers to help provide technical or administrative assistance to ensure the program is managed with the utmost quality and efficiency. Consequently, the parent and/or guardian and the enrollee (child/children) voluntarily release our third-party affiliates, and third-party community programs and volunteers from all implications of liability as a result of working with CodeCrew now or in the future.

In compliance, to the fullest extent of the law, CodeCrew acknowledges that unlawful practices are prohibited in return and not accepted by third-party affiliates, third-party community programs, and/or volunteers, and background checks are required in some of these processes. CodeCrew reserves the right to be released from all risks of liability by your child or children participating in the camp or its events because participation is solely voluntary.

I do know CodeCrew and its third-party affiliates are not liable for any child enrolled under false pretenses. I understand and agree to these Terms and Conditions voluntarily and confirm that I am the Parent/Guardian of the Participant.

## DATA COLLECTION AND SHARING CONSENT

Many CodeCrew funders and community stakeholders require data about student participants and/or participants' households. I give permission to CodeCrew to collect information from myself and/or my child via online or written surveys, questionnaires, interviews, electronic signatures, and focus groups. I give permission for this information to be collected and stored via a secure third-party case management system within the United States only. I understand that CodeCrew may share this information with third-party affiliates for research purposes and/or to evaluate the program's effectiveness.

CodeCrew will NOT sell personally identifiable data about any student participants and/or participants' households to any third parties. I understand this information will be summarized/aggregated and in an anonymous format if it should be shared with unaffiliated third parties.

## EMAIL ACCOUNT CONSENT

During the course of the program, participating students may use an email account. I give CodeCrew permission to create an email account for my student on the CodeCrew Gmail server (code-crew.org). No student will be encouraged by CodeCrew to use this email account outside of CodeCrew purposes. These email accounts are managed by CodeCrew in the event that there is a loss of password/activation. CodeCrew will not monitor incoming/outgoing emails. CodeCrew retains the right to deactivate an email account if deemed used inappropriately. CodeCrew asks that parents and guardians have full access to these email accounts to maintain safe and appropriate web usage.
